Good Morning! Colossians, Chapter 2, Verses 13 and 14 say...

# /COL 2:13

When you were (spiritually) dead in your transgressions and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He (God the Father) made you alive together with Him (the Lord Jesus Christ...by preordaining that you believers would be placed into union with Him), having forgiven us all our transgressions...

# /COL 2:14

...having canceled out the certificate of debt consisting of decrees against us, which was hostile to us; and He has taken it (the debt) out of the way, having nailed it to the Cross.

The Cross moved you from the slavery of a lifestyle of law to the freedom of the sphere of grace. Because of this, we believers in Christ are filled with a joy that is inexpressible. As we prepare for bible study, you can ask yourself, "What has God put in my life which gives me joy?"

<WHERE IS YOUR SOUL TUNED? no verse...let the verse pop in on the next click>

The Word of God refers to bible study as a time of RENEWING, a time to let God renew your joy. God the Holy Spirit fills your deficiencies of thought with the truths of the Word of God, and He unveils to you the Plan of God the Father for your life. John, Chapter 15, Verse 11 says...

/JOH 15:11 "These things I (the Lord Jesus Christ) have spoken to you so that My joy may be in you, and that your joy may be made full."

Literally, the Lord is suggesting that He wants His joy to keep on filling the deficiencies in your joy, regardless of what circumstance might be your present reality. He has made perfect provision for your happiness...you simply choose to let His happiness pervade your life. Welcome to a place where you can "in humility receive the Word implanted, which is able to save your souls."

# /TODAY'S STUDY Where is the Love?\

One question haunts me after twenty-five years of biblical study... Where is the love? Why is it that I can tell you anything you want to know about the sin nature...anything you want to know about the Old Self...

anything you want to know about adjusting to the justice of God (which is a crock of cacca, by the way)...anything you want to know about the fifth cycle of discipline... anything you want to know about warning discipline, intensive discipline, and the sin unto death...anything you want to know about mental attitude sins, sins of the tongue, and overt sins...anything you want to know about Satan...but virtually nothing about the wonder of God's essence...about how much God loves me...about the new self...and about the new spiritual species? Why are the messages coming from allegedly doctrinal pulpits all about what's wrong with us as Christians?

Where is the love?

Why are the messages coming from allegedly doctrinal pulpits always about how mean God is? And as much of my time as I have dedicated to being a diligent and serious student of the Word of God, why isn't Christianity a more relaxing experience for me before recently? Why are you now talking about how free you feel?

Sorry...but I just don't believe that legalistic crap any more. Here's what I want to know...what is right with us as Christians? What do we have to be encouraged about? And if that makes me "Pastor Pollyanna," so be it. I think we have SO MUCH to be encouraged about and SO MUCH to learn about our God and about how He really feels about us...

Where is the love?

I've been taught that justice is God's point of contact with us...that at the fall of creatures, His point of contact with us shifted from His love to His justice. Okay. I get it. God can't compromise His essence. But how is it that an immutable God changes? I haven't heard that explanation yet, but I can predict it. Better yet, why is it that every New Testament verse that talks about God's justice is something that is being done in favor of the believer in Christ? Turn to Luke Chapter 18...

<Read Luke, Chapter 18, Verses 1 to 8> Focus on these verses...

/LUK 18:6-8 And the Lord said, "Hear what the unrighteous judge said;//now, will not God bring about justice for His elect (believers in Christ) who cry to Him

day and night, and will He delay long over them?//I tell you that He will bring about justice for them quickly.

Take a five-minute break.

/BREAK When I Think About Home

Welcome back...

Turn to Luke, Chapter 15, Verse 11...we are well familiar with the story of the prodigal son...yet when we study this story, our focus is virtually always on the son, but seldom on the compassion of the father...

<Read Luke, Chapter 15, Verses 11-32> Focus on this verse...

/LUK 15:20 But while he was still a long way off, his (the prodigal son's) father saw him and felt compassion for him, and ran and embraced him and kissed him.\

Yes...before the son "confessed his sins," the father had already embraced him and kissed him and the father had already put a major feast in motion for him...a restoration of all the privileges of being a son. THAT'S how God feels about you! Yet why is the focus of this a story as taught from doctrinal pulpits virtually always on the son who squanders his wealth and on the self-righteousness of the other son, when this is really a story about how wonderful our father is, and how much our father loves us unconditionally, even when we squander our estate.

Where is the love?

Why is it that we hear so much about, and why are so concerned about our sins, and the divine discipline associated with them? What is divine discipline?

/DIVINE DISCIPLINE Training in a character pattern\

God is training His believers. He has given us the Holy Spirit to complete us. You know Ephesians, Chapter 5, Verse 18 well...

## /EPH 5:18

And do not get drunk with wine, for that is dissipation, but be filled with the Spirit...

A better translation of the Greek expression *En Pneumati* in this verse would be...

## /EPH 5:18

And do not get drunk with wine, for that is dissipation, but keep on being made complete by the agency of God the Holy Spirit...

This is the passive voice in Greek...there is nothing we have to do to be filled with the Spirit. It is an irrevocable gift of God. You cannot lose the filling of the Spirit. Anyone who says you can is lying.

God the Holy Spirit has been charged with the task of conforming us believers to the image of Christ...Romans, Chapter 8, Verse 29 says...

/ROM 8:29 For those whom He (God the Father) foreknew, He also predestined to become conformed to the image of His Son...\

Philippians, Chapter 1, Verse 6...

/PHI 1:6

For I am confident of this very thing, that He (God the Father) who began a (divine) good work in (the creation of) you will (keep on) perfect(ing) it (will finish it) until the day of Christ Jesus.

If divine discipline is so negative, why then did David WANT it? Turn to First Chronicles, Chapter 21...

<Read, First Chronicles, Chapter 21, Verses 1 to 13>

/1CH 21:13

David said to Gad, "I am in great distress; please let me fall into the hand of the Lord, for His mercies are very great. But do not let me fall into the hand of man."

And God did show mercy to David...

/REV 3:19 'Those whom I (the Lord Jesus Christ) love (personally), I reprove and discipline...'\

I have been taught that as a believer in Christ, I will experience a temporary moment of shame at the Judgment Seat of Christ. The verse used to justify this false doctrine is First John, Chapter 2, Verse 28...

/1JO 2:28 Now, little children, abide in Him, so that when He appears, we may have confidence and not shrink away from Him in shame at His coming.

Let's look at the context of this verse...beginning at First John, Chapter 2, Verse 25...the focus of the first two chapters of First John has John talking to believers about unbelievers...

<Read First John, Chapter 2, Verses 25 to 29>

Maybe this translation will shed light on the verse...

/1JO 2:28

Now, little children (believers in Christ), abide in (union with) Him, so that when He appears, we may have confidence and not shrink away (experience shame) from Him...at His coming (as unbelievers will).

This verse isn't even talking about the Judgment Seat of Christ...it's talking about His advent...and whether that is the Rapture or the Second Coming of Christ, both of those situations are positive for the believer. Look at the Wuest translation of this verse...

## /1JO 2:28 (Wuest Translation)

And now, little children [born-ones, bairns], be continually abiding in Him, in order that whenever He is made visible, we may have instant freedom of speech and not be made to shrink away from Him in shame at His coming and personal presence.

What I'm being asked to believe is that I am going to be face-to-face one day with the Person that I have been waiting to see for my whole life, the Lord Jesus Christ, and when I meet Him, my reaction to Him is going to be shame. Bull! What will His reaction be to me? Arms wide open...welcome home son! Luke, Chapter 15, Verse 20...

## /LUK 15:20

But while he was still a long way off, his (the prodigal son's) father saw him and felt compassion for him, and ran and embraced him and kissed him.

And if there were shame at the Judgment Seat of Christ for believers, what would the shame be for? For sins? Well I'm under the impression that sins won't be mentioned at the Judgment Seat of Christ, so I don't exactly understand the basis of the shame...but I know for sure that my paid for sins will not be the basis of my shame.

Where is the love?

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Here's the point...ultimately, going over and over the lies of legalism is defensive and divisive, even though it must be done. For those of you in this congregation and others who have been victimized for years by ministries that claimed to be doctrinal which were teaching heresy, this is a traumatic lesson. Be encouraged! I want you to know how magnificent God thinks you believers are, and I want you to know that this ministry is committed to teaching you about it.

God owns us...and that means something!
