/TODAY'S STUDY Thanks Be to God for the Resurrection From the Death of Legalism\

Turn in your bibles to John, Chapter 11...

<Read John, Chapter 11, Verse 1 to 46>

/JOH 11:25

Jesus said to her (Martha), "I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies (spiritually)..."

/JOH 11:26

...and everyone who lives (the Zoe life...the resurrection life) and believes in *Me* (has faith in me) will never die (the second death). Do you believe this? "\

Our God, the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ has risen from the dead, just as He said He would. He keeps His promises. And whether you believe it or not does not change the established fact that the Lord Jesus Christ is seated at the right hand of God the Father this very day, and because we are in union with the Lord, we sit right there with Him.

Peter proclaims the wonder of the Lord on the day of Pentecost, the day when the Holy Spirit was given...a victorious day for Peter after his denial of knowing the Lord...we read excerpts from this great day in the second chapter of Acts...beginning at Verse 22...

/ACT 2:22

"Men of Israel, listen to these words: Jesus the Nazarene, a man attested to you by God (the Father) with miracles and wonders and signs which God (the Father) performed through Him (the Lord Jesus Christ) in your midst, just as you yourselves know"

/ACT 2:23

"...this (God)-Man (the Lord Jesus Christ), delivered over by the predetermined plan and foreknowledge of God (the Father), you nailed to a cross by the hands of godless men and put Him to death."

/ACT 2:24

"But God (the Father) raised Him (the Lord Jesus Christ) up again, putting an end to the agony of death, since it was impossible for Him (the Lord Jesus Christ) to be held in its power."

/ACT 2:32-33

"This Jesus, God (the Father) raised up again, to which we are all witnesses.//Therefore having been exalted to the right hand of God (the Father), and having received from (God) the Father the promise of (God) the Holy Spirit, He has poured forth this which you both see and hear."

Because of the Lord Jesus Christ's resurrection, we have the hope of resurrection as well...not only in the life to come, but in the present life we believers in Christ live right now...the Zoe Life...the resurrection life here on earth.

This year we have watched our God resurrect us from the death of legalism and we have seen Him move us into an accurate viewpoint of Christianity. We are embarking on a journey into a free future...to learn about Christianity without the interference of Satanic and human viewpoints. We have learned that the only way to truly understand Christianity is to view it from God's eyes.

Look at Titus, Chapter 2, Verses 11 to 14...

/TIT 2:11-12

For the grace of God has appeared (is made clearly visible to us), bringing (the possibility of) salvation to (be received by) all men,//instructing us (often the hard way) to deny (reject) ungodliness and worldly desires and to live sensibly, righteously and godly (living the spiritual life) in the present age...\

/TIT 2:13-14

...(all while) looking for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, (the Lord) Christ Jesus,//who gave Himself for us to redeem (purchase) us from (slavery to) every lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for (divine) good deeds.\

As a result of resurrection, we have a blessed hope...that the Lord Jesus Christ will reappear to resurrect us.

Welcome back!

What is resurrection? It comes from the Greek word anastasis...

/Resurrection

Anastasis To stand up again

The return of a person from the dead, in a body which will never die again...the beginning of eternity for a creature...an event that will occur in the lives of all creatures at a future time.

Church Age believers will experience resurrection at a future time. It's called *exanastasis* in the Greek...

/Exanastasis

To come out from...The Rapture...the exit resurrection...the plucking of all believers from the earth to meet the Lord in the air to receive their resurrection bodies\

Look at First Thessalonians, Chapter 4, Verse 13...

/1TH 4:13

CCC

But we do not want you to be uninformed (ignorant), brethren (believers in Christ), about those (believers) who are asleep (physically dead but face-to-face with the Lord), so that you will not grieve as do the rest (unbelievers) who have no hope (absolute confidence).

/1TH 4:14

For if (1) we believe that Jesus died and rose again (in resurrection, and we do), even so God (the Father) will bring with Him those who have fallen asleep in (union with the Lord) Jesus (Christ).

/1TH 4:15

For this we (keep on) say(ing) to you by the word of the Lord, that we (believers in Christ) who are alive and remain (surviving our loved ones) until the coming of the Lord (The Rapture ... the exit resurrection), will not precede (be resurrected before) those who have fallen asleep (physically died).

/1TH 4:16-17

For the Lord (Jesus Christ) Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel and with the (summoning) trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first.//Then we who are alive and remain (the living survivors of our departed brethren) will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we shall always be with the Lord.

/1TH 4:18 *Therefore comfort one another with these words.*\

This is your resurrection as Church Age believers, a day coming soon.

We refuse to believe that our God would subject us to the slavery of legalism after giving us so many blessings...

...and put on the new self, which in the likeness of God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth. \langle
