Good Morning! First John, Chapter 4, Verse 18 says...

/1JO 4:18

There is no fear in (unconditional) love; but perfect love (unconditional love) casts out fear, because fear involves punishment, and the one who fears is not perfected in love.\

Unconditional love comes from our regenerate, New Self nature. Fear is a product of our Old Self nature. There is no place for fear or for cowardice in God's service. Fear is torment in the soul. Fear is the sin that cuts off your thinking.

Fear has a valuable function, however, if we let it. It can drive us right into God's arms. When we are afraid we can easily admit, I can't do this...I don't know how...I'm afraid...and we can ask God to step in and to do anything for us. He will happily intervene on our behalf.

/TODAY'S STUDY

Unconditional Love Separates\

It's easy to see, upon a surface inspection of it, that there are similarities between Christianity and religion... similarities between Christianity and legalism. Yet it is not the similarities that we must inspect. We must inspect the differences. In a comparison between Roman Catholicism and Christianity, it's easy to say that both disciplines believe in the Lord Jesus Christ. Since this similarity exists, it would be easy, on the surface, to conclude that Christianity and Roman Catholicism are the same. Yet a deeper inspection would reveal that Roman Catholics do not believe in the Lord Jesus Christ of biblical Christianity. The Lord Jesus Christ of biblical Christianity said on the Cross...in John, Chapter 19, Verse 30...

/JOH 19:30

Therefore when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" And He bowed His head and gave up His spirit.\

The Lord Jesus Christ's work on the Cross finished the work of salvation, our redemption, once and for all time. Galatians, Chapter 3, verse 13 says...

/GAL 3:13

(The Lord Jesus) Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us — for it is written, "CURSED IS EVERYONE WHO HANGS ON A TREE"

Roman Catholicism does not believe that Christ's work on the Cross finished salvation and the work of redemption. Therefore the Christ of Roman Catholicism needs help to finish redemption. The Catechism of the Catholic Church, Verse 1405 says...

/CCC 1405

There is no surer pledge or dearer sign of this great hope in the new heavens and new earth "in which righteousness dwells," than the Eucharist...every time this mystery is celebrated, "the work of our redemption is carried on" and we "break the one bread that provides the medicine of immortality, the antidote for death, and the food that makes us live forever in Jesus Christ."

The same is true of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, also known as the Mormons and LDS. They allege to believe in Christ, but they no not believe He is God, and they do not believe he is co-equal, co-infinite and co-eternal...they do not believe that He is the same in essence as God

the Father and God the Hoy Spirit. They believe that the three are separate beings, not One God in three separate and distinct persons.

Therefore, it is not the similarities we inspect...it is the differences, when we compare Christianity and religion or Christianity and legalism. Why? Because differences separate. Take a five-minute break and we'll look at how this connects to unconditional love.

/BREAK

When I Think About Home

Welcome back!

Unconditional love separates. While Christians, believers in Christ, may be similar to unbelievers in a lot of ways...often even undistinguishable from an unbeliever in conduct, there are foundational and invisible differences that separate...one of those is the ability to express unconditional love.

To be sure, Gandhi, Buddha, Muhammad, and Martin Luther King, to name a few, may have indeed been good men, similar in many ways to Jesus Christ in His true humanity...yet I think it is safe to say that there were big differences...none of these men died on a Cross to pay for sins (1PE 2:24)...none of these men rose from the dead (MAT 28:6, JOH 11:25, 1CO 15:20)...none of these men were born without a sin nature (MAT 1:23)...none of these men lived sinless lives (HEB 4:15).

Unconditional love separates. Conditional love is an "I love you if" philosophy. I love you if you are "good." I don't love you if you are "bad." Unconditional love is an "I love you no matter what" philosophy. I love you if you are "good." I love you if you are "bad." I love you if you are heinous and despicable. When we, as Christians, fail at living this unconditional love, we are missing the most important lesson in biblical Christianity because unconditional love separates. What kind of love does your parenting reflect?

Unconditional love separates when we are parenting. Christian parents who incorporate unconditional love into raising children are reflecting the love of their divine parent. Christian parents who incorporate conditional love into raising children are reflecting the actions of unbelievers. In other words,

they are not living the difference that separates. Our divine parent has a parenting plan...

/PARENTING VISION

2PE 3:9

The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish (in the lake of fire) but for all to come to repentance (a change of mind about the Lord Jesus Christ).

/PARENTING OBJECTIVE (Salvation)

ACT 16:31

They said, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and (everyone in) your household (who also believes)."

/PARENTING STRATEGY (Salvation)

ROM 12:2

And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.\

/PARENTING OBJECTIVE (The Christian Way of Living)

2PE 3:18

...but grow in the (sphere of) grace and (in the) knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory, both now and to the day of eternity. Amen.\

/PARENTING STRATEGY (The Christian Way of Living)

EPH 4:22-24

...in reference to your former manner of life, you lay aside the old self, which is being corrupted in accordance with the lusts of deceit,//and that you be renewed in the spirit of your mind,//and put on the new self, which in the likeness of God has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth \

Our divine parent, our God, has a parenting plan for our lives, and it has a vision of our future...an objective for each of the phases of our lives...a strategy for each phase...and tactics for each phase's plan. What are tactics?

/TACTICS

The detailed actions that support an objective and a strategy...the milestones of progress that are part of a plan\

In God's plan for us as Christians, there is a milestone that allow us to experience religiosity...there is a milestone that allows us to experience legalism...there is a milestone that allows us to experience lasciviousness... there is a milestone that allows us to go through a period of anti-nomian attitude...not that the Lord would have us do any of these things, nor that He actually wants us to experience these things, but that He knows we will and He allows them for our instruction. Turn in your bibles to James, Chapter 1, Verse 13...

/JAM 1:13

Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am being tempted by God;" for God cannot be tempted by evil, and He Himself does not tempt anyone.\

/JAM 1:14

But each one is tempted when he is carried away and enticed by his own lust.

/JAM 1:15

Then when lust has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and when sin is accomplished, it brings forth death.\

/JAM 1:16

Do not be deceived, my beloved brethren.\

Said another way, God is not interested in us doing things that hurt ourselves, but He is willing to allow us to learn through our mistakes. Do you have this attitude with your children? Or are you expecting them to live up to some lame human expectation that you are imposing on them, thinking that when they do this lame thing, that they will be right in your eyes? That is conditional love at its finest...indistinguishable from the approach of unbeliever parents.

So what are some of the tactics that you can employ in your parenting plan as it develops?

/PARENTING TACTIC
Win Your Children's Hearts\

Many parents are simply tyrants. They assume that because they are parents, they are "owed" respect. Therefore they do not think they have the responsibility as parents and as leaders to win the hearts of their children.

This is absurd in any realm. It's absurd in the realm of sports. A coach cannot come into a situation and demand respect, even if he is accomplished.

<PHIL JACKSON>

It's absurd in the Christian Way of Life. The Lord doesn't assume that because He created us we owe Him our loyalty or respect. Look at the unbeliever. He is created by God yet he rejects a relationship with God. And that is His prerogative. God considers it His job to win the unbeliever over, and He does it with unconditional love.

Here's the truth...if your children don't perceive your love as unconditional, ultimately it drives them away.

What are you doing as parents to win the hearts of your children?

What is your parenting plan? Make sure it is chock full of unconditional love.
