Good morning! Turn in your bibles to Ephesians, Chapter 3, Verses 14 to 19...

/EPH 3:14-16

For this reason (because the grace of God was given to me to preach) I (Paul) bow my knees (in prayer) before (God) the Father,//from whom every family in heaven (angels) and on earth (humans) derives its name,//that He (God the Father) would grant you (personally), according to the riches of His glory (out of His glorious riches), to be strengthened with (living, enabling) power through (God) His (Holy) Spirit indwelling the inner man (innermost being)...\

/EPH 3:17-19

...so that Christ may dwell (and feel at home) in your hearts through (your) faith; and that you, being rooted (like a plant) and grounded (with a firm foundation) in (unconditional) love,//may be able to comprehend with all the saints (believers in Christ) what is the breadth (wide) and length (long) and height (high) and depth (deep nature of unconditional love),//and to know the (unconditional) love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled up (pleroo) to all the fullness (pleroma) of God (the Father).

This is one of the most beautiful prayers ever prayed. Here it is without all the parentheses...

/EPH 3:14-16

Because the grace of God was given to me to preach, I, Paul bow my knees in prayer before God the Father,//by whom every family in heaven and on earth, both angels and humans, are named,//that God the Father would grant that you personally, out of His glorious riches, would be strengthened with His living and enabling power through God the Holy Spirit who is indwelling your innermost being...\

/EPH 3:17-19

...so that Christ might feel at home in your hearts because of your faith; and that you, being rooted by God like a plant and grounded by God with His firm foundation, unconditional love,//may be able to comprehend, you and all the believers in Christ, how wide and long and high and deep is the nature of His unconditional love,//and to know for certain, through this unconditional love of Christ, which is way better than just biblical knowledge, that your deficiencies are completely covered by all the fullness of God the Father.\

What is Paul praying on your behalf? He is praying that you, as a believer in Christ, recognize the importance of your union with Christ...you are "rooted," firmly planted in Christ. He is praying that you are "grounded," that as a believer in Christ you understand that the Word of God is your life's foundation. He is praying that you understand that God does not only have your back...*how wide and long and high and deep* means God has your back, your front, your side, your top and your bottom...He has you completely surrounded...covered on all sides. He is praying that your knowledge go beyond just biblical knowledge...gnosis...academic knowledge to a full knowledge of God and to taking full advantage of His glorious riches.

Welcome to bible study.

Welcome to Barah Ministries. My name is Rory Clark. The Lord Jesus Christ is God. The Bible is His infallible Word...and His exact thinking...a book with no errors...with no contradictions...with no lies...the Bible is the truth. Welcome to the place where you can receive the Word of God implanted, which is able to deliver your souls.

/TODAY'S STUDY Romans Chapter 1 - Are You Prepared for the Quiz?\

This is the ninth lesson in our study of Romans, and I thought it would be a good idea to clean up some of the chronology of what we have learned so far, while simultaneously adding to your understanding of Pauls' resume. As we study the bible, everything doesn't unfold neatly. Our learning bounces us around all over the place, and sometime everything jumbles together in such a way that it perverts our understanding of a very simple biblical subject.

So in the next three lessons I want us to summarize our learning thus far, as we have transitioned into an in depth study of Paul's letter to the Romans. I also want to see how well prepared you are for the upcoming quiz, that will test your diligence in being an active learner rather than a passive one.

I think like an author. I like to approach biblical study from clear structure and simple messages, so it is a vexation to my spirit that biblical information does not come at us in a clear and linear fashion. However, I know God knows what He is doing, and I trust, more than anything, that He will give us all the information we need to have a thorough understanding of everything we learn, so that we can make use of it in our Christian walk...while under pressure...so we can do as Paul suggests in Ephesians, Chapter 4, Verse 1...

/EPH 4:1

Therefore I (Paul), the (voluntary) prisoner of the Lord (for the sake of you Gentiles), implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called...

We walk in a manner worthy of the call of God to which we have been called, a calling that comes through our union with Jesus Christ, when we strike a perfect balance between our commitment to the Lord and our commitment to the personal life things we must manage. We walk in a manner worthy when we put God on the throne of our lives and then use God and His Word as our "rooting" and our "grounding…" as our foundational friend and our foundational thought pattern.

The bible is a chronicle of divine history, and when we study the bible we are studying divine history.

Divine history is divided into a series of time periods called dispensations... each dispensation has common attributes...each dispensation has unique attributes.

<DISPENSATIONS SLIDE>

For example, in every dispensation, there is only one way to get to heaven... in John, Chapter 14, beginning at Verse 2, the Lord Jesus Christ points out the way...

/JOH 14:2

"In My Father's house are many dwelling places (mansions); if it were not so, I (the Lord Jesus Christ) would have told you; for I go (to My Father's house) to prepare a place for you."

/JOH 14:3

"If (1) I go and prepare a place for you (and I do), I (the Lord Jesus Christ) will come again and receive you to Myself, that where I am, there you may be also."

/JOH 14:4

ROM

"And you know the way where I (the Lord Jesus Christ) am going (I have been teaching you)."

/JOH 14:5

Thomas said to Him, "Lord (indicating His knowledge that Jesus is God), we do not know where You are going, how (by what means) do we (come to) know the way?"

/JOH 14:6

Jesus said to him (Thomas), "I (the Lord Jesus Christ) am the way (to salvation), and I (the Lord Jesus Christ am) the truth (through the Word of God), and I (the Lord Jesus Christ am) the (Zoe) life (the resurrection life); no one comes to (God) the Father but through (believing in) Me.

In every dispensation there are unique attributes...Ephesians, Chapter 5, verse 18 says...

/EPH 5:18

And do not get drunk (being fully influenced) with wine, for that is dissipation, but be filled (fully influenced by God) with (by means of) the (indwelling) Spirit...

Being "fully influenced by the indwelling Holy Spirit"...En Pneumati...is unique to the Church Age.

We are embarking on an in depth study of the bible, and it is my sincere hope that the depth of your study increases.

There are 66 books in the bible.

If you look within a physical copy of the bible, it has an index that delineates the name of each book.

<OLD TESTAMENT (39) – THE CROSS- NEW TESTAMENT (27) SLIDE>

There are 39 books in the Old Testament. The Old Testament is the instruction set to believers in the Age of Israel.

There are 27 books in the New Testament. The New Testament is the instruction set to believers in the Church Age, which is the present era of divine history.

<DISPENSATIONS SLIDE>

You are a Church Age believer...and the New Testament is His set of instructions to all of you... the New Testament gives you His instructions to the "new spiritual species" which God the Father created to eliminate the barrier to relationship between God and Man. Second Corinthians, Chapter 5, Verse 17 says...

/2CO 5:17

Therefore if (1) anyone is in (union with) Christ (and all believers in Christ are), he is a new creature (a new spiritual species); the (sovereignty of the) old (self) things (have) passed away (have lost their power); behold, new (spiritual species) things have come.

If you are a believer in the Lord Jesus Christ, you are in union with the Lord Jesus Christ, which means you have an unbreakable relationship with the Sovereign God of the Universe.

The incarnation of the Lord Jesus Christ, His thirty-three years on earth, leading to a death on a Cross and the resurrection from the dead, is the dividing line between the Old Testament and the New Testament.

<OLD TESTAMENT (39) - CROSS- NEW TESTAMENT (27) SLIDE>

Anything from the Old Testament that is relevant to New Testament believers is repeated in the New Testament.

The first four books of the New Testament detail what is called the INCARNATION of Christ, a thirty-three year period...a chronicle of His time on earth.

/JOH 1:14

And the Word (God the Son) became flesh (Jesus Christ), and dwelt (tabernacled) among us, and we saw (beheld) His glory, glory as of the only begotten (uniquely born One) from (God) the Father, full of grace and (full of) truth.
