SHOW TEASER (1:00)

When we are oblivious to something, we seldom bring it to memory. Signs of it can be right in front of us, yet we ignore them. Oblivious. That's the way most of us are when it comes to the subject of God. Oblivious. Most of us have put God out of our minds...we don't make regular time for God. The Lord Jesus Christ, who is God, created us yet we don't have time to get to know Him. If what I am saying induces guilt in you, maybe you're oblivious in the matter of God...maybe you're guilty as charged. But if you're listening to this radio program, maybe you're the opposite...maybe you're interested in God. What's true for your life is a matter between you and the Lord. But whether you are oblivious or not, you will meet the Lord Jesus Christ face-to-face one day. Are you asleep to God? Welcome to the program...

TODAY'S LESSON (23:50 with the song) The Divine Wake-Up Call

We're studying the second passage in Paul's letter to the Romans, which extends from Romans Chapter 1, Verse 18 to Romans, Chapter 3, Verse 20...many theologians and Pastors call this the "consequences of sin" section of the letter...I call it the best DIVINE WAKE-UP CALL ever written. The Lord tells us in very certain terms that being oblivious to Him and to His Word is no excuse.

Oblivious.

Many of us are oblivious to the fact that the Lord Jesus Christ, our God, is not at all confusing. First Corinthians, Chapter 14, Verse 33 says...

First Corinthians 14:33 ... for God is not a God of confusion...

Many believe the lie that "God works in mysterious ways," instead of understanding that God works in crystal clear and very predictable ways. With God, everything is one...Ephesians, Chapter 4, Verses 4 to 6 say...

Ephesians 4:4-6

There is one body (the Body of Christ...the Church) and one God the Holy Spirit, just as also you were called in one hope of your calling (to

salvation);//(there is) one Lord (Jesus Christ), one faith (Christianity), one baptism (the baptism of the Holy Spirit),//one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.

With the Lord everything is one...everything is clear, just like a wake up call is clear. I have stayed in hotels for many nights in my life...I'd estimate that I have spent more than ten years worth of nights in hotels...more than 4000 nights in hotel beds...thank God they have started to make hotel beds more comfortable...and in hotels before you go to bed, you ask for a wake up call. At the appointed time the hotel operator calls to tell you it's time to get up...and if you don't wake up when the operator calls, you will oversleep...which can be a disaster... it's not wise to be oblivious to the wake up call. Well it's not wise to be oblivious to the divine wake-up call either, and in this passage of study in the letter to the Romans, the Lord Jesus Christ is making some things clear to the entire human race, whether they are informed or oblivious. Ignorance of the truth is neither an excuse in the plan of God, nor in law for that matter. If you murder someone, and you don't know it's illegal, it's still illegal. If you are oblivious to God and His Word, it still applies to you.

Well the second passage in Paul's letter to the Romans, which extends from Romans Chapter 1, Verse 18 to Romans, Chapter 3, Verse 20 is THE DIVINE WAKE-UP CALL...and I have never gotten a wake up call as clear and as beautiful as this one. The passage we'll study today begins at Romans, Chapter 2, Verse 1...but let me remind you of a few things we learned in Romans, Chapter 1, before we move on.

With God there is only one way to get to heaven...John, Chapter 14, Verse 6...

John 14:6

Jesus said to doubting Thomas, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through believing in Me."

The Lord Jesus Christ is the ONLY way to heaven. All roads do not lead to God...ONE road leads to heaven, and His name is the Lord Jesus Christ... Matthew, Chapter 7, Verses 13 and 14...

Matthew 7:13-14

"Enter through the narrow gate; for the gate is wide and the way is broad that leads to destruction, and there are many who enter through it.//For the gate is small and the way is narrow that leads to life, and there are few who find it."

The Lord Jesus Christ is the narrow gate. To amplify this idea, the Lord is more specific, through the apostle Paul, in Romans, Chapter 1, Verse 17...

Romans 1:17

FOR in the gospel message of the Lord Jesus Christ the righteousness of God the Father is revealed, from faith (in the Lord Jesus Christ for salvation) to faith (in the Lord Jesus Christ for all things); as it is written, "BUT THE RIGHTEOUS man (the believer in Christ) SHALL LIVE BY FAITH (by placing his confidence in the Lord Jesus Christ)."

We are to place our complete confidence in the Lord Jesus Christ for salvation...and when we do, we are credited with the Lord's own righteousness, which is our admission ticket to heaven. We have full assurance that God will keep His promises. The alternative to having the Lord's righteousness is to incur God the Father's wrath... Romans, Chapter 1, Verse 18...

Romans 1:18

FOR the wrath of God the Father is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and (against all) unrighteousness of men (who are unbelievers) who suppress the truth (of the gospel message) in unrighteousness...

For those who reject a relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ, for those who reject His unconditional love, they have decided to pay for their own sins...and sin always incurs the wrath of God the Father. So rather than letting the Lord Jesus Christ, God the Father's Son, take on the Father's wrath for them, unbelievers want a "do it yourself" salvation. That doesn't work too well. John, Chapter 3, Verse 36...

John 3:36

He who believes in the Son has eternal life (the resurrection life); but he who does not obey the (command to believe in the) Son will not see (the eternal life...the resurrection) life, but instead the wrath of God the Father (the Lake of Fire) abides on him.

There is no one who will be able to stand before the Lord Jesus Christ and say he never knew about God..."oblivious" won't work with God...Romans, Chapter 1, Verse 20...

Romans 1:20

For since the creation of the world (the Lord Jesus Christ's) invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature (divinity), have been clearly seen (by all mankind), being understood through what has been made in the entire created universe, so that all mankind (especially those who practice ungodliness and unrighteousness) are without excuse (in the matter of knowing God).

Unbelievers would rather worship themselves or worship Satan than worship the Lord... Romans, Chapter 1, Verses 22 and 23 confirm it...

Romans 1:22

Professing to be wise, (those who practice ungodliness and unrighteousness...unbelievers) became fools...

Romans 1:23

...and (they) exchanged the glory of the incorruptible God for an image (an idol) in the form of corruptible man and (in the form) of birds and (in the form of) four-footed animals and (in the form of) crawling creatures.

All of us either have a God with a capital 'G'...the Lord Jesus Christ...or a "god" with a small 'g' ... any other idol that sits on the throne of our soul. Who is your God?

So now we turn the page. Romans Chapter 1, Verse 18 to Romans, Chapter 3, Verse 20 is best described as God's indictment of the entire human race. We've looked at the first section of the passage, where Paul is talking to the Gentiles...now let's hear what Paul has to say to the Jews, beginning at Romans, Chapter 2, Verse 1. Let's hear the first eleven verses...

Romans 2:1

Therefore you have no excuse, everyone of you who passes judgment, for in that which you judge another, you condemn yourself; for you who judge practice the same things.

Romans 2:2

And we know that the judgment of God rightly falls upon those who practice such things.

Romans 2:3

But do you suppose this, O man, when you pass judgment on those who practice such things and do the same yourself, that you will escape the judgment of God?

Romans 2:4

Or do you think lightly of the riches of His kindness and tolerance and patience, not knowing that the kindness of God leads you to repentance?

Romans 2:5

But because of your stubbornness and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God...

Romans 2:6

...who WILL RENDER TO EACH PERSON ACCORDING TO HIS DEEDS...

Romans 2:7

...to those who by perseverance in doing good seek for glory and honor and immortality, eternal life...

Romans 2:8

...but to those who are selfishly ambitious and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, wrath and indignation.

Romans 2:9

There will be tribulation and distress for every soul of man who does evil, of the Jew first and also of the Greek...

Romans 2:10

...but glory and honor and peace to everyone who does good, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

Romans 2:11

For there is no partiality with God.

If you review Romans, Chapter 1, Verse 18 to Romans, Chapter 1, Verse 32, the first part of this indictment of the human race, Paul is describing a lifestyle offer. A word we could attach to that lifestyle offer is the LASCIVIOUS LIFESTYLE. It is one of Satan's two lifestyle offers. I call it the lifestyle of "sex, drugs and rock and roll." I've had quite a few members of my congregation express their displeasure that I would make rock and roll a part of this lifestyle. They believe rock and roll is a pure and chaste art form...so in flexibility, I have been willing to call LASCIVIOUSNESS the lifestyle of "sex, drugs and country music," to highlight my general dislike of country music and to make my congregation members like me again. I'm sorry, in advance, to the people who like country music. Now *you* don't like me either! Oh well...

What is lasciviousness? It is a lifestyle inclined toward open indulgence in the lusts of the flesh, including an insatiable greed and a relentless pursuit of sexual things or for any other things that are obviously not part of God's plan for mankind...many of them illegal things. All of you know of people who have "gone astray" into this lifestyle, many of them your friends... perhaps many of them living right in your own home...perhaps you have even had your time in this lifestyle. I know I certainly have...there's no hint of human perfection in my life...I have a scrapbook of stupidity just like you do.

In Romans, Chapter 2, the Lord indicts Satan's other lifestyle offer... LEGALISM. What is legalism? Legalism is smugly moralistic conduct which is often intolerant of the opinions and behavior of others...it is having or showing an exaggerated awareness of your own virtue...engagement in self-love and self-flattery...the thought that you are better than others, and that you are due a set of privileges because of it...the thought that God likes you because of something inherently good in you.

So in Romans, Chapter 2, Paul turns his indictment to the legalistic ones...the Jews. Romans, Chapter 2, Verse 1...

Romans 2:1

Therefore you (moral ones) have no excuse, everyone of you who passes judgment, for in that which you judge (condemn) another, you condemn yourself; for you who judge (others) practice the same things (others do...things just as bad, and perhaps worse).

Satan's two lifestlyes...the LASCIVIOUS LIFESTYLE and the LEGALISTIC LIFESTYLE. Two ends of the same horrible pole...total depravity. If I admire one lifestyle over the other, and again, I have lived both, I much admire the LASCIVIOUS LIFESTYLE because they are not phonies. They are not living a godly life, and they know it, and they readily admit it. I have found people who are living this lifestyle a pleasure to deal with over the years. They are people with whom you can have a real conversation.

Those who are engaged in the LEGALISTIC LIFESTYLE are boorish... they're inconsiderate...insensitive...judgmental...in short, they think they are "all that!" They're not. They think they are better than everyone else. Romans, Chapter 2, Verses 2 and 3...

Romans 2:2

And we know that the judgment of God (also) rightly falls (not only on those who practice lasciviousness, but also) upon those who practice (legalism).

Romans 2:3

But do you suppose this, O (men and women who practice legalism), (that) when you pass judgment on those who practice (lasciviousness) and do the same (things) yourself (or worse), that you will escape the judgment of God?

If you were to give another name to the LASCIVIOUS LIFESTYLE, you could call it the immoral lifestyle. If you were to give another name to the LEGALISTIC LIFESTYLE, you could call it the moral lifestyle. Paul is reminding those who practice the moral lifestyle, that they also practice the immorality of lasciviousness as well, they just do it "in the closet," out of sight of people. They have a great act…an apparently "clean" outer game…but the Lord describes their "inside" game…Matthew, Chapter 23, Verse 27...

Matthew 23:27

"Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, you hypocrites! For you are like whitewashed tombs which on the outside appear beautiful, but inside they are full of dead men's bones and all uncleanness.

Those who practice the LEGALISTIC LIFESTYLE may commit their immorality out of the sight of humans, but they are not out of the sight of God. Here's an example...John, Chapter 8, Verses 1 to 11...

John 8:1-11

But Jesus went to the Mount of Olives.//Early in the morning He came again into the temple, and all the people were coming to Him; and He sat down and began to teach them.//The scribes and the Pharisees brought a woman caught in adultery, and having set her in the center of the court,//they said to Him, "Teacher, this woman has been caught in adultery, in the very act.// Now in the Mosaic Law Moses commanded us to stone such women: what then do You say?"//They were saying this, testing Him, so that they might have grounds for accusing Him. But Jesus stooped down and with His finger wrote on the ground.//But when they persisted in asking Him, He straightened up, and said to them, "He who is without sin among you, let him be the first to throw a stone at her."//Again He stooped down and wrote on the ground.//When they heard it, they began to go out one by one, beginning with the older ones, and He was left alone with the woman, where she was, in the center of the court.//Straightening up, Jesus said to her, "Woman, where are they? Did no one condemn you?"//She said, "No one, Lord." And Jesus said, "I do not condemn you, either. Go. From now on sin no more."

The Divine Wake-Up Call. All of us are guilty.

I think it's pretty funny that the moralistic, legalistic scribes and Pharisees only brought the woman who was caught in the very act of adultery. What happened to the man? Was the woman committing adultery with herself? Hardly. It is much more likely that she was committing adultery with a scribe or a Pharisees1

Jesus says to them, "He who is without sin among you, let him be the first to throw a stone at her." Ooops! No one we know on earth fills that bill. The divine indictment...the divine wake-up call...leaves all of us in a pretty tough situation. Whether we practice LASCIVIOUSNESS or LEGALISM...we are falling well short of the plan of God. There's only one way out. Here's Barah Ministries Song Worship Leader June Murphy, singing a song she wrote and produced, telling us the way out of the predicament...the song is called, "There's Just One Hope" ...

SONG There's Just One Hope June Murphy 4:10

Thank you June... Romans, Chapter 2, Verses 1 to 3...the continuation of the divine wake-up call...a pronouncement that whether you run a moral lifestyle or an immoral lifestyle...you are guilty before God and require a Savior...

Romans 2:1

Therefore you (moral ones) have no excuse, everyone of you who passes judgment, for in that which you judge (condemn) another, you condemn yourself; for you who judge (others) practice the same things (others do...things just as bad, and perhaps worse).

Romans 2:2

And we know that the judgment of God (also) rightly falls (not only on those who practice lasciviousness, but also) upon those who practice (legalism).

Romans 2:3

But do you suppose this, O (men and women who practice legalism), (that) when you pass judgment on those who practice (lasciviousness) and do the same (things) yourself (or worse), that you will escape the judgment of God?

So the thing I'd have you think about is these things...are you oblivious? Have you put God out of your mind? Do you make regular time for God? Are you taking a part of your one hundred and sixty eight hours of time each week to get to know Him?

I sure hope so. It's worth it. Here's what the Lord Jesus Christ wants for you...First Timothy, Chapter 2, Verses 3 to 6...

First Timothy 2:3-6

This is good and acceptable in the sight of the God who is our Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ//who desires all men to be saved and who desires all men to come to the knowledge of the truth.//For there is one God the Father, and one mediator also between God the Father and men, the man Christ Jesus,// who gave Himself as a ransom for all, the testimony given at the proper time.

There is ONLY one God...ONLY one way to approach Him...the narrow road. Christ.
